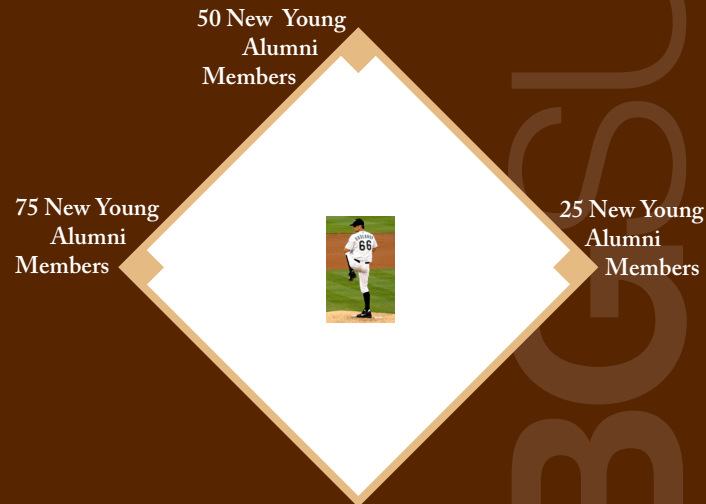

The Burke Badenhop — Young Alumni Challenge




Burke Badenhop got a first hand look at the Falcon Club and the ongoing effort to recruit new members when he worked as an office assistant during his minor league off seasons for the Detroit Tigers.

At the time, he was challenged to put a game plan together to recruit young alumni to support Falcon Athletics. Badenhop, an All-American, a Falcon Senior Student-Athlete of the Year, and a MAC Bob James Postgraduate Scholar, spent hours researching other such programs and laying the groundwork for the Falcon Club Young Alumni program.

Fast forward two years and he again is preparing a game plan, though this time not as an assistant, but as a major league pitcher for the Florida Marlins interested in “delivering his own pitch” to encourage other young alumni to “get in the game”.

With a gift from Badenhop, young alumni (within 5 years of graduation), including former letter winners, can join the Falcon Club for \$25 (half the usual price of the Young Alumni rate) and he will match the same amount. A gift can be earmarked 100% toward his or her favorite sport. Young alumni heeding the call from Badenhop will receive all the benefits associated with giving at the Young Alumni rate, including access to Falcon Club hospitality events at games, weekly Falcon Land Updates and knowing that they are leading by example and supporting their Falcons.

The Burke Badenhop Young Alumni Challenge will run through June 31, 2009 and the goal is to attract 100 new Young Alumni members to “get in the game”.
